The Millville Army Air Field Museum has been hosting tours to many groups throughout the years with great reviews of the quality of the exhibit, veteran tour guides, and the enjoyment of the experience.

We want to pass on the heritage of the people of Millville who came together with great patriotism to support the 1,500 Thunderbolt (P-47) pilots who trained here and the 10,000 military personnel who came through Millville in service to our country.

The museum charges a \$100.00 "Historical Interpretive" fee to help us continue to expand the museum's historic preservation effort. This donation will include a one hour guided tour by one or more of our docents. Our museum offers so much WWII history that we can't wait to share this with you.

We also have two other buildings (Library & Link Trainer) that are within walking distance. Both buildings were from WWII and have been restored. The "Henry E. Wyble Library Research and Education Center" houses an extensive collection of aviation books, periodicals, video tapes, and manuscripts part of the Cumberland County 'Clues' library network. There is also a collection of Hot Wheels, Barbie Dolls, and models on display. The Link Trainer Building is located next to our library. This building houses a World War II operational Link Trainer which is a flight simulator that was used to train pilots to fly under low visibility conditions by instrument training.

Stop and see our gift shop with affordable memorabilia.

If there is anything special we can do to accommodate your visit, please ask. We have an outside courtyard area with picnic tables and benches if you would like to have lunch.
